We would like to provide clarification regarding the Ordoline workflow and the clinical support behind each treatment plan.

Ordoline is not only a clear aligner manufacturer. Ordoline is an orthodontist-guided treatment system, where every treatment plan is prepared, reviewed and verified with orthodontic expertise behind it.

In practice, the workflow is as follows:

1. **The treating doctor submits the case**

The treating doctor submits the patient's records, including intraoral scans, photographs, X-rays and clinical instructions.

2. **The case is clinically assessed**

Ordoline evaluates whether the case is suitable for clear aligner treatment and whether additional orthodontic mechanics, auxiliaries or clinical limitations should be considered.

3. **The treatment plan is prepared by the Ordoline clinical planning team**

The treatment setup is prepared according to the treating doctor's prescription, clinical objectives and submitted patient records.

4. **Every treatment plan is reviewed with orthodontic expertise**

Behind every Ordoline treatment plan, there is an orthodontist involved in the planning and review process. The orthodontist evaluates the clinical logic of the case, including treatment sequence, tooth movement predictability, anchorage, biomechanics, attachments, IPR, elastics, auxiliaries and overall feasibility of the planned treatment.

5. **The treating doctor receives a guided treatment plan**

The treating doctor receives a clinically reviewed treatment plan together with Ordoline's recommendations and guidance. This allows the doctor to treat the patient with the support of orthodontic expertise throughout the planning process.

6. **Final approval remains with the treating doctor**

Before production, the treating doctor reviews and approves the treatment plan. The treating doctor remains responsible for the patient, clinical examination, communication, follow-up visits and final clinical decisions.

Therefore, doctors working with Ordoline are not working independently without orthodontic support. They are supported by a structured, orthodontist-guided workflow, where each treatment plan is checked and validated before aligners are manufactured.

This is one of the key strengths of the Ordoline system: clear aligner treatment is supported by orthodontic knowledge, clinical planning experience and professional guidance at the treatment planning stage.

We believe this workflow enables treating doctors to provide clear aligner treatments safely, predictably and responsibly, while having access to orthodontic guidance behind every treatment plan.
